Letter to a non-priority creditor to ask for the balance of your account with them

This letter is used when you want to find out how much you owe your creditors and you are going to draw up a financial statement so that realistic offers of repayment can be made to all creditors on an equitable basis.

While I realise you may not be happy with this, I feel it is the most practical thing to do at this time. Please also freeze interest on my account to stop my financial circumstances getting worse.
